**NEW BUSINESS**

1. Mr. Agoglia – Speeding/safety concerns on Brookside Road

Mr. Agoglia was not present at this meeting. Highway Patrol Officer Ray Matus spoke and discussed the results of the speed counter. The results were:

ADT = 919  
Average speed = 28 mph  
85% = 32 mph

Mr. Agoglia was advised that this road did not meet the criteria for speed humps. Officer Matus further advised that he can go to his Commissioner if they would like to override the opinion of Staff Traffic Committee. Staff Traffic will place a speed board on Brookside Road to advise motorists of their speed.

4. Susan Byrne has concerns about speeding, stop sign violations and wrong way violations on Louella Court.

Staff Traffic will put an email out for enforcement for the "Do Not Enter" sign that motorists are currently passing through. Staff Traffic recommends that management cut the tree back on the corner in order to make the stop sign visible that is being blocked. Field Leader Bill Cassidy will replace "Thru traffic sign" with a new sign. Also, the "Watch Children" sign will be replaced with the lime green sign.
