Minutes of the Meeting for August 2018

Present: Paige Maz, Heather Gill, Charles Boschen
Absent: Regina Majercak

The meeting started at 7:00

1. Chairperson Paige Maz called the meeting to order.
2. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
3. Review/approve meeting minutes of June 14, 2018 and July 26, 2018 SWMAC Meetings.
 - Meeting Minutes were not approved due to not having a quorum. Meeting will be reviewed and approved at next meeting.
4. Public Comment on Stormwater Matters
 - Paul Perrot, resident, asked how many stormwater projects were started and completed in 2016, 2017, and 2018.; Why has it taken so long to address these issues?
 - i. Steve Norcini, P.E. – Several infrastructure projects have been done, as in culverts and infrastructure pipe replacement
 1. Currently there are contract bids out for Basin Retrofits; the cleaning, repairing and installation of sediment reductions for North Wayne Field Basin is out to bid; Maplewood Outfall, Malin Road culvert is in the design phase; Roberts Road Culvert is in the Design phase; Wootton Road storm sewer, Mill Road, Arthur Road are waiting for cost proposal and approval.
 2. Flood reduction options in North Wayne and the Poplar bypass; Midland Ave
 3. Create a Stormwater Management facility at the South Wayne Municipal parking lot
 4. Creating full utilization of the Stormwater Management System that is currently underutilized at the Radnor Middle School
 - Deanna Doane – 565 W Wayne Ave would like to know if the Maplewood project is to mitigate the flooding?
 - i. Steve Norcini, P.E., Township Engineer explained that the Maplewood Project was an extension of the existing storm sewer and not a flood mitigation project
 - Rob McCullough – 27 Oakford Road – Would like to know more information on the Mill Creek, the Dam at Mill Creek and the manual release of the dam by the homeowner. Is there any talk about the Township acquiring that piece of property?
 - i. Steve Norcini, P.E, Township Engineer explained that this is a dam operation plan and that it is the responsibility of the swim club.
 - John Sheehan – 409 Windsor Ave – How do you put the August 13th event into perspective other events in the past 10-15 years? What are the one or two drivers that is causing this problem.
 - i. Paige Maz responded that she feels this has been the biggest one to date.

- ii. Paige and Heather feel that keeping the inlet drains clean of debris can help with flooding. And Implementing smart and effective storm water projects.
 - John Sheeran asked if there has been any thought given to tax residents who have exceeded the impervious coverage threshold
 - i. Heather explained that exceeding impervious coverage is a Zoning issue.
 - ii. Robert Zienkowski, Township Manager explained that there has been discussions about starting to utilize some of the properties. If they are willing to store water on their property and hold it or release it slowly the township may be able to reduce their stormwater fee.
 - Jeff Adams – Arbordale – Managing their yards in a normal rain has been a struggle. He is asking for assistance and or guidance to resolve the water issue.
 - i. Heather mentioned that rain gardens and rain barrels is an option
 - ii. Robert Zienkowski, Township Manager has asked that the residents email the committee, your commissioner, Township Engineer or him directly when drastic changes occur
 - Tina Landis – 124 W Lancaster – showed pictures of the damage from the August 13th storm.
 - i. Heather explained that this is a Penndot issue.
 - ii. Robert Zienkowski, Township Manager will speak to them about this issue. He will also bring videos to the next meeting to show these areas to view
5. Coordination with residents on future path of Banbury Francis Windsor (BFW) project.
- Heather and Paige met with the Arborist at Banbury Francis Way to discuss various scenarios. 5 Trees could be a conflict; the condition of these trees show severe dieback from bacterial leaf scorch and decaying conditions. John Hosbauch, township arborist mentioned that he did not see a healthy thriving tree out of the five that would be impacted.
 - Heather discussed options
 - Township Resident would like to see plans before moving forward.
 - Heather would like the SWMAC Board consider going to the Board of Commissioners if the residents are in favor of any type of plan, 25yr, 15 year, etc.
 - Robert Zienkowski, Township Manager, suggested that if the neighbors wanted a meeting on the street, he would take care of making it happen.
 - John Sheeran discussed neighborhood issues and possible solutions

Recommendations: Going forth with a more formal 10 year design to see the extent of the design and to provide landscaping and a rain garden and to look at potential teen intersection. To proceed without Board approval with the alternative that the SWMAC Commission go to the Board and recommend approval
