- I. Health officers report posted to website. 15 Inspections, 5 pool inspections and 2 public health complaints. On 2/10 Attorney General Shapiro announced lawsuit against JUUL at RHS. Marie posted CDC guidance on COVID-19 on the Radnor website. On 2/12 Marie attended Suicide Prevention Training. March 6-7 is national unplugging day. Marie clarified the request from resident to look unto drinking water in Radnor Township.**

II. Old Business:

- a. Student projects are in draft form. Survey questions need review by school officials. Students are seeking survey question approval from school officials.**
- b. Vaping update: Linda and Superintendent Flanagan gave a presentation to a group of Educational Support professionals in Jan. Linda provided updated cases of lung related illnesses and deaths due to vaping. PA passed House Bill 473 raising the age to 21 for the purpose of buying tobacco and vaping products. On Jan 2 a Federal ban on flavor vaping products went into effect. Main Line Health is working on screening tools for patients.**
- c. Aqua statement on water quality: Concerned residents can call Aqua directly for information. Radnor water goes through the Pickering water treatment plant. The Radnor BOC is looking for a recommendation for the BOH. Marie will invite Aqua representatives to attend future BOH meeting.**
