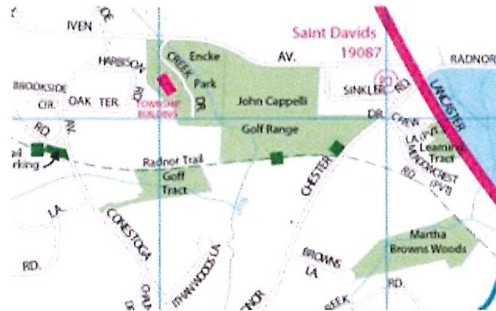
Radnor Township Recreation & Community Programming Department Announces Night at the Ball Park! Wiffleball Classic & Fireworks Event! at Encke Park
