What is the Little Free Library?

A Little Free Library is a 'take a book', 'return a book' free public book exchange. The most common version of the Little Free Library is a small wooden box on a post consisting of books contributed or shared by members of the community.

During this time of COVID-19 and emergency declaration in Radnor Township, all Little Free Libraries in our parks will serve to support families in need by providing a discrete place where people can freely donate and retrieve non-perishable food items to assist their families.

Where are the Park Little Libraries/Pantries Located?

- ◆ **Encke Park Playground along Iven Avenue near the Township Building - 305 Iven Avenue, Wayne**
- ◆ **Odorisio Park near the playground - 418 Fairview Road, Wayne**
- ◆ **Warren Filipone Park along South Devon Avenue - 400 South Devon Avenue, Wayne**



What foods items can be donated/found in the Little Free Pantries?

- ◆ **canned tuna/chicken/meats**
- ◆ **canned beans & canned veggies**
- ◆ **canned fruit**
- ◆ **jams/jellies/peanut butter**
- ◆ **spaghetti sauce/pasta**
- ◆ **boxed foods such as mac & cheese/rice & mashed potatoes**
- ◆ **cereal/oats**
- ◆ **toiletries (i.e. toilet paper, toothpaste, shampoo, soap, etc.)**
