- ⇒ All skaters will learn about skateboarding and park etiquette, safety, and fundamentals over the course of 3 sessions. Fun skate games too!
- ⇒ Cost for all 3 sessions is: \$75 per skater

Equipment is not provided, you must bring your own skateboard.
