- Continued COVID-19 Coordination

### PLEAC Accreditation Activities

*2021 Start process*

- Adopt Established nationally and State Recognized "Best Practices" standards
- Reduction of risk & exposure to lawsuits
- Improves Agency/Community Relations
- Adopt 126 Standards which are Reflective of Best Practices in Law Enforcement
- Collaborate with PLEAC Consultant Regularly





# High Density Response Units (2)

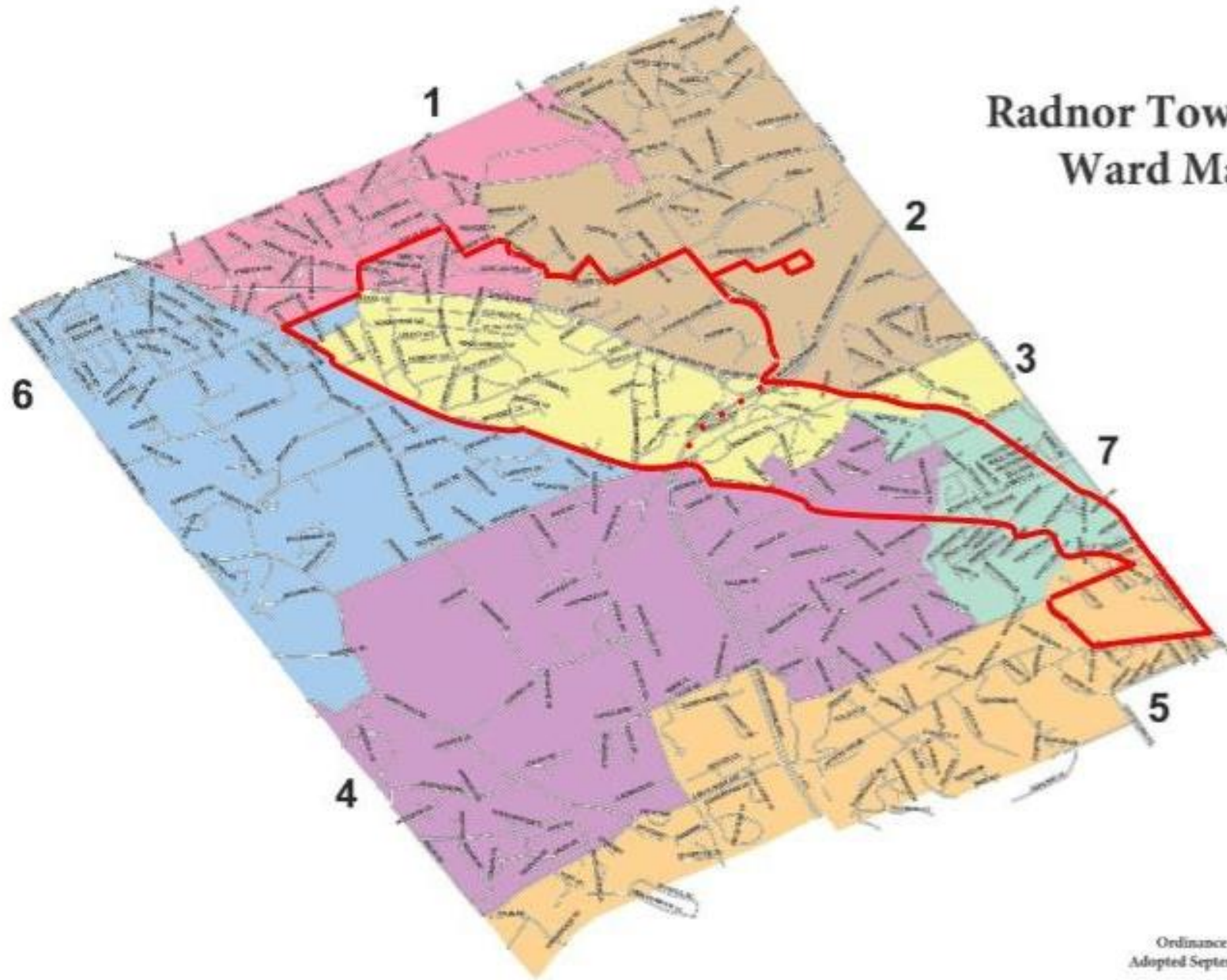
## 2 Additional Officers to the Department

- Active Shooter / Significant Emergency Response time shortened  
(Seconds Matter according to recent study)
- Overall Service availability dramatically increased
- Increased uniformed officer response during peak times in densely populated sectors of Township
- Commit to one additional beat during school/business days  
(2 on most days)
- Flexibility to assign second beat during off-peak times as dictated by needs and activities
- Increase Uniformed Patrol availability in all areas of the Township  
(When High Density Car is in service)
