SPRING 2021 SKATEBOARD CLINICS



This is an instructional clinic-style clinic taught by local skater Carl Cortez and is for **beginner** and **intermediate** street skateboarders in grades 1 to 8. **Beginner** skaters will develop stance, turning and pushing, while building healthy confidence on your board! **Intermediate** skaters will develop ollies, flip tricks, and more! All skaters will learn about skateboarding and park etiquette, safety, and fundamentals over the course of 3 sessions. Fun skate games too! The majority of the clinic will take place in the

parking lot next to the Radnor Skatepark in order to provide a spacious environment conducive to learning and practicing skills. Equipment is not provided, you must bring your own skateboard. Safety gear is recommended.
